



COVID 19 Guidance for Learners in Group Training – face to face

Your health & safety is paramount to us at Amplio Training.

In line with COVID-19 safety guidelines we now have new procedures in place for delivering safe training.

When booking on line through our website please click in the appropriate box, to confirm that you have read, and agree with, the requirements below.

1. Learners will be asked to wear a face mask on entering the training venue. Please supply your own masks.
2. The Trainer, upon arrival, will prevent any person who has symptoms of COVID-19 from entering the classroom - the symptoms include a new and persistent cough, fever, and loss of smell and/or taste.
3. This will ideally be completed by temperature screening with a thermal thermometer.
4. The learner will be questioned to ensure that neither they, nor any person from their household, have displayed symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
5. If any learner shows symptoms of COVID-19 or confirms that they, or a member of their household, have shown symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days then they will be refused entry to the classroom and advised to attend training once they have been clear of all symptoms for 14 days.
6. Should any learner develop symptoms of COVID-19 during training then they must leave the classroom.
7. All persons who have been in the classroom must also follow Government isolation guidelines to prevent the further spread of the disease.
8. Learners must contact Amplio Training if the learners, or a member of their household, display symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days of completion of training. All other learners will be notified of the situation and asked to follow the appropriate Government guidance.
9. All learners must thoroughly wash their hands upon each instance of access to and egress from the classroom, using the hand washing facilities and hand sanitisers provided.
10. Learners must sneeze and cough into tissues provided dispose of them and wash their hands immediately. If a tissue is not immediately available, then learners should be encouraged to cough or sneeze into the bent elbow.
11. Learners must comply with the social distancing measures taken within classroom and building and ensure they always maintain a distance of 2 metres. With regards to first aid, there are detailed adaptations to the assessment process, that will allow valid assessments whilst still respecting social distancing.
12. Refreshments and meals will not be supplied so please bring your own bottles or flasks for only you to handle.
